Please note: Prices in this edition have not all been rechecked. Prices are currently coming down. You may be able to negotiate a better deal than prices listed here.

The installation costs below are based on installation of a 90 cm dish (in most cases), cabling and an FTA (Free to Air) satellite decoder (set top box), the size of a VCR. Tuning will be included. In many cases where the installers supply the equipment themselves they will supply their own brand of decoders. Make sure you verify that the type of receiver they install has a warranty and can be serviced in Australia.

Questions which the satellite installer might ask you:

What is the satellite you are tuning to? **Optus B3**

What form will the transmission be in? **Ku Band**

What Transponder? **2**

Which channel on the Transponder? **Virtual Channel 9**

What are the transmissions about? **Personal development lectures**

South Australia - Adelaide

1. First recommendation is that people buy the equipment from Media Star Satellite Systems, and have it installed by them. Fully installed \$799 (includes cabling and dish mounts, however could cost up to \$75-100 more, if installation is not standard, and they usually are not). Rod has stated that upon installation he will give out an invoice guaranteeing service for 12 months. Any call out in this period will be free for service faults. Anyone initially ringing him should mention Igor Jacoby. Current satellite receiver provided in this system is the MediaStar D7.1 Digital Receiver.

2. Second recommendation is to get the equipment from Melbourne Satellites (freight cost approximately \$50) and have it installed by Antenna World. Bill charges \$250 for installation. Call out fee free if he has not done a proper job, e.g., blowing over of dish. This would not apply to an exceptional storm.

There is a \$60 call out fee if the customer stuffs up (there is no charge for this in the first month) or the equipment from Melbourne Satellites is faulty.
